The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of finals!

TSR Riders Finals – 1st and 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

Class 35: Novice Working Hunter Pony. Not exceeding 13.2h.h. This class will have cross poles only not exceeding 40cm. Can be done on or off lead rein. This class is kindly sponsored by Give a Dog a Bone.

Class 36: Novice Working Hunter Pony. Ponies under 15.h.h. Jumps approx. 50cm.

Class 37: Open Working Hunter Pony. Ponies under 15.h.h. Jumps approx. 60cm.

Class 38: Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter. Jumps approx. 60cm.

This class will be followed by a lunch break for the judge. During this break the Working Hunter clear rounds will open again.

Class 39: Novice Working Hunter Horse. Horses 15.h.h and over. Jumps approx. 70cm.

Class 40: Intermediate Working Hunter Horse: Horses 15.h.h and over. Jumps approx. 80cm.

Class 41: Open Working Hunter Horse: Horses 15.h.h and over. Jumps approx. 1m.

Class 42: Botanica/ BHS Scotland Working Hunter series 2019 Qualifying Class. Horses must be 15.h.h or over and 4 years old or over. Riders must be 18 years old or over.

To be able to compete in the final the rider must be a member of the BHS.

The course will consist of 8-12 fences at approx. 3'6". It will be judged in line with the Sports Horse of Great Britain rules.

To qualify: The first three horse/rider partnerships will qualify even if they have not jumped clear in the jumping phase. If one of these has previously qualified, their qualification may be handed down to the fourth placed competitor provided they had a clear round in the jumping.

To compete at the final riders must be a BHS Member and this must be registered prior to the date of the final.

The Botanica/ BHS Working Hunter Series 2019 Final will be held at Blair Castle in August 2019.
